The purpose of the hearing will be to hear any and all comments regarding a Planned Unit Development application known as the Village at Rosy Mound, which proposes a mixed-use residential senior living campus that would consist of a three-story 116-unit Congregate Apartment Building for ages 55+; a single-story 110-unit Assisted Living Facility; and 9 single-story Cottages that are comprised of 27-units for ages 55+ and consist of two- to four-unit attached single-family dwellings. The site would be developed in 4 phases, is located on 26.92 acres near Lakeshore Drive and Rosy Mound Drive, and includes Parcel Numbers 70-07-04-200-025, 70-07-04-400-028, and part of 70-07-04-100-028.
